

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS: TRADE SHOW

- What is the definition of a Returning Vendor?
 - The vendor had a booth at OFFF the previous year
- When does registration open for vendors?
 - March 31, 2010
- When does registration close
 - For returning vendors to obtain the same spot as last year entries need to be postmarked no later than June 21, 2010
 - Spaces will be filled as long as there is space
- What do I get for my booth fee:
 - The space your booth is assigned
 - Your Company's name on our website as a participating vendor
 - Your Company's name on the vendor listing available at the Registration desk
 - Use of power in your vendor space if space has access to power.
- How are vendor spaces awarded
 - Vendor spaces are awarded by returning vendor first, then by postmark
 - OFFF reserves the right to select vendors based on the appropriateness of the products and or services offered by the vendor. Please see our mission statement below

OFFF's Mission Statement

Our Mission is to exhibit and demonstrate the full spectrum of natural fibers (plant and animal), from beginning to end. That is, from the animal or raw fiber to the finished product.

- What do I get when I pay for Website advertising:
 - Link to your company's website
 - A short description (provided by you) of what your company has to offer
- Is a map available of the grounds with vendor spaces identified?
 - I will post the map once ALL vendor spaces are assigned. Please note the map is not to scale
- Can we use pay pal to pay for our registration
 - We are still working out the details and hope to have this available for 2010

- Why is it important to check in at the registration desk?
 - When customers ask if you are at the festival we can let them know you are here
 - Obtaining your refund should you be due one
 - Booth space changes/issues
 - Power in booth spaces: we will do the best we can to match up vendors requesting spaces with power.
